Slide 1: Low Emission Zones logo. Background image is a car parked on the street.

Slide 2: “are being introduced”

Slide 3: “to Scotland’s four largest cities in mid-2022.” A map shows the 4 cities – Aberdeen, Dundee, Edinburgh and Glasgow.
