Are you ready?

If you drive in Aberdeen, **Dundee, Edinburgh** or **Glasgow**you'll need to know about

Low Emission Zones (LEZs).

Aberdeen's LEZ will be enforced from 1 June 2024

Dundee's LEZ will be enforced from 30 May 2024

Glasgow's LEZ will be enforced from 1 June 2023 Edinburgh's LEZ will be enforced from 1 June 2024

Here's a snapshot of what it's all about...

- LEZs restrict access for the most polluting vehicles to improve air quality. This helps protect public health within cities, making them more attractive places to live, work and visit.
- Vehicles that do not meet the emission standards set for a LEZ will be issued a penalty charge notice if they drive within the zone.



Vehicle standards

LEZ emission standards are specified with regards to the Euro emission standards, and are as follows:

- Euro 4 for petrol cars and vans
- · Euro 6 for diesel cars and vans
- Euro VI for buses, coaches and HGVs

Motorbikes and mopeds are not included in the current LEZ schemes and no restrictions will apply.

Exemptions

Certain exemptions will apply, including vehicles for disabled persons (which includes Blue Badge holders) and emergency vehicles.

Grace periods

Local grace periods now apply until enforcement begins.

- In Glasgow, the LEZ already applies to buses. For other vehicle types, enforcement will start on 1 June 2023 (1 June 2024 for residents within the zone)
- Dundee will start enforcement on 30 May 2024
- Aberdeen will start enforcement on 1 June 2024

Edinburgh will start enforcement on 1 June 2024
