LEZ general animation script

Low Emission Zones were introduced to Scotland's four largest cities in May 2022.

Glasgow's city centre LEZ enforcement has started.

When being driven in a Low Emission Zone vehicles must meet the LEZ minimum emission standards.

Vehicles that meet these standards pollute much less than those that do not.

You can check your vehicle now using the vehicle checker on our website.

If a vehicle is driven in the LEZ and doesn't meet the emission standards, the owner will receive a Penalty Charge Notice.

Grace periods still apply in Aberdeen, Dundee and Edinburgh, which are set to begin LEZ enforcement in summer 2024.

Dundee will be enforced from the 30th of May 2024.

Aberdeen and Edinburgh will be enforced from the 1st of June 2024.

Certain exemptions will apply, including for Blue Badge holders who can register for a Long Term or One Day exemption.

LEZs help to protect public health, improve air quality and support Scotland's climate targets.

LEZs promote public transport, cleaner vehicles and more active travel such as walking, wheeling and cycling.
