LEZ myth-busting animation - 2023

Low Emission Zones were introduced to Scotland's four largest cities in May 2022.

LEZs improve air quality and protect public health. They will make city centres better places to live, work and visit.

Glasgow's LEZ began enforcement on the 1<sup>st</sup> June 2023. Aberdeen, Dundee and Edinburgh's LEZs will be enforced in 2024.

You don't pay to enter a Low Emission Zone. Owners of non-compliant vehicles will receive Penalty Charge Notices.

Blue Badge holders are exempt from LEZ restrictions. Check our website to find out more about LEZ exemptions.

Funding is available to help individuals and businesses prepare for LEZs. Check our website to find out more.

Residents in Glasgow's LEZ have an extra year to get ready. Enforcement for residents within the zone begins 1 June 2024.

Grace periods still apply in Aberdeen, Dundee and Edinburgh, which are set to begin LEZ enforcement in summer 2024.

Dundee will be enforced from the 30<sup>th</sup> of May 2024.

Aberdeen and Edinburgh will be enforced from the 1<sup>st</sup> of June 2024.
